

The Perfect GYPO Special Event Station

What does an Activator do during a Get Your Park ON! event, to be a Prefect Special Event Station (SES)?

1. Operate each day during the GYPO event, activating multiple references

The object of the GYPO events is to focus activity during the event periods, and to give all hunters worldwide the opportunity to boost their award totals.

2. Make a minimum of 44 QSOs at each reference with the goal of making 100-150 QSOs in each

Give each hunter that desires a QSO an opportunity to do so. Two or three hours at a reference helps provide this.

3. Operate all three popular modes, SSB, CW, FT4/8

Not all hunters have the capability to operate each mode that may be used by a SES. To give the broadest opportunity for hunters to make a QSO, these hunter's limitations must be considered.

4. Select operating bands and hours giving DX hunters the best opportunity to make QSO

GYPO is an international event. Hunters worldwide are interested in making contacts with SESs.

5. Operate using a special event callsign

A special callsign helps readily identify GYPO SESs

6. Post planned activations on WWFF Agenda

By posting planned activities, hunters know best when to look for the SES's activations. Here is a link: <https://wwff.co/agenda>

7. Update QRZ station page for the callsign of the SES

Stations frequently will search QRZ for information about the special event and SES operator. QSL information will be provided there too.

In addition to working new reference, hunters frequently try to make a SES Clean Sweep by working all SESs. This is done on a continental and worldwide basis. The Perfect SES considers this.

Of course, in life it's difficult to be perfect, so these are not strict requirements. Everyone has restrictions and limitations. That is understood.
